Cub Scout Leadership Pow Wow Class Descriptions

All Tied Up & Totin' Chip: Knot tying is important to the Cub Scout program. Learn how to tie knots and then teach your cubs as part of their requirements. Games and activities for teaching these to your den. You will learn hands on skills you will need in order to teach your Cubs the proper and safe way to use a knife. Tips on helping boys earn their Totin' Chip.

Beyond the Badge - Awards and Recognition: Discover the awards your Cubs can earn. There is more to Cub Scouting than rank advancement opportunities. This course will explore extra awards Cub Scouts can earn.

Ceremonies: Why are ceremonies so important to the Cub Scout Program? Learn the purpose and types of ceremonies, including tips to make them your own or even write your own. Make award presentations timely, meaningful and fun. Learn planning, organization and presentation basics for a memorable event. There are always some new ideas – come and get them!

Crafts on a Budget / Nature Crafts and Activities: Create and build things utilizing inexpensive materials. How-to's for people of all crafting skills. Ideas and much more. Come check out the ideas and make a few things to take home with you. Along with projects and activities that puts the OUT into SCOUTS for your den and pack. (2 hours)

Cub Scouting for All: "Managing diversity is the process of creating and maintaining an environment that naturally enables all participants to contribute to their full potential..." – R. Roosevelt Thomas Jr. – This class will cover Understanding Diversity, culture diversity and disability awareness; Valuing Diversity, inclusion is within Everyone's Ability; and Managing Diversity, fully utilizing all the people involved.

Fire Starters & Leave No Trace Fires – Discover how to turn household items into fire starters that are safe to use. Hands on activities making fire starters to take home. Learn techniques to have a leave no trace fire.

Games: You may have heard the phrase "Scouting is a game with a purpose". Get ready for fun and adventure! There are all different kinds of games for Scouts: indoor, outdoor, quiet, noisy – and they all meet a need. Class will cover age appropriateness and values of Scout Law.

Growls & Howls, Skits & Songs: Storytelling, songs, skits, chants, yells – this is an exciting part of scouting. Learn how to create both your own skits and songs as well as how to discern what content is appropriate. Learn where and how to use them. Skit ideas and resources, including campfire helps. Give boys confidence with fun, appropriate skits.

Leader recognition / thank you: Thanking your leaders is a very important part leadership retention. Learn fun ways to thank your leaders. Learn about leaders knots and other recognition for your leaders.

Lions & Tigers, Oh My!: Learn fun ways for Lions and Tigers to fuel their imagination and creativity. This session will give you ideas on how to involve your Lion and Tiger Cub partners; finding and utilizing their talents and skills. How to make the most of your adventures, including field trips.

Maestro! Creating music is one way to share feelings and express ideas. Every culture has its own music and unique instruments. Explore some of their musical sounds. You will learn about many different ways to make musical instruments and "make-and-take" some instruments as well.

Cub Scout Leadership Pow Wow Class Descriptions

NOVA: The Boy Scouts of America's NOVA Awards program incorporates learning with cool activities and exposure to science, technology, engineering and mathematics for Cub Scouts. Learn more about the NOVA awards and how to earn them. Not a hands on class.

Citizenship and Our American Flag – Etiquette & Ceremonies: Citizenship is a very important part of scouting. Learn fun ways to teach the scouts citizenship and how to be good citizens. Teach Scouts the proper respect for the flag at all functions and the various ceremonies involved. Appropriate procedures for flag ceremonies and retiring flags too tired to fly. You will be involved in a flag retirement ceremony at the end of the Pow Wow.

Pack Meeting Sparklers: How to add more FUN into your pack meetings! Don't forget to include the adults. Do you want to create your own pack meeting theme or utilize existing themes on the BSA website? This class will also include how to effectively use the Cubmaster minute, scout resources and incorporate all the elements of a successful pack meeting.

Super Science and Beyond: Boys love science! Think science is difficult to teach? Make it fun with simple experiments using easily obtainable materials from home or supermarket. Discover ways to implement the science-related activities in the Tiger, Cub Scout and Webelos rank advancements. Learn more about the STEM and NOVA programs. (2 hours)

Outdoor Cooking: Create some "easy, yummy" dutch oven dishes and campfire cooking. Learn how to adjust temperature and coal placement. Easy recipes and techniques for outdoor cooking. Snacking will be involved. (2 hour)

Take It Outdoors: Let's get "out of the box" and go outside for some adventure! Ideas on how to add elements of the great outdoors to your den meetings and complete the outdoor requirements for their adventures.

Teaching with Food: Learn how to use food to teach scouts science experiments and scout skills. Also, just some fun recipes to have fun with your scouts.
