Safety Moment

High adventure camps/camping require more physical fitness than other Scouting adventures. Keep these things in mind:

- Identify and disclose any medical issues that could put you or other campers at risk - then decide if it is appropriate for you to participate.
- Complete health forms A, B, and C, and review the "High Adventure Risk Advisory" section with your provider.
- Have an honest discussion with your provider if it is appropriate for you to participate in the trip.
- Make sure your physical fitness is up to the task! Can you walk 3 miles in one hour without stopping, do 10 pushups, pass the Scouting America swim test, and go up three flights of stairs? If not, it's time to improve your fitness before the trek!
