### Safety Moment

Many Scouts participate in holiday-related fundraisers, or simply help decorate their own home. Keep these safety precautions in mind:

- Electrical safety: Don't plug more than 3 strands of lights into a standard electrical plug.
   Use a power strip for additional strands.
- Fire safety: Keep all open flames, such as candles, at least three feet away from flammable materials.
- Ladder safety: When hanging decorations, use a sturdy step ladder, never a chair. Do not hang anything from fire sprinklers.
- Inspect equipment: Before use, inspect all lights, decorations, and extension cords for damage.

#### Commissioners

Mike O'Donnell, District Commissioner

- Remember that there is no such thing as "Recharter" anymore. It has been replaced with membership renewal and unit renewal, which are separate processes. Individual youth and adult memberships are valid for 12 months from the date of registration, regardless of the unit's renewal date. The annual unit renewal process replaced the former recharter process and is handled by unit leadership once per year; because all the units in the MVD are legacy units (not new units), their renewal must be completed by **December 7, 2025.** We recommend you get started now! Please see here for a detailed "how-to". Of note, individual members are responsible for renewing their own memberships each year. However, in some cases, a unit may choose to renew memberships on behalf of its members. Please reach out to your **Unit Commissioner** if you need help! All adults included in your Unit Renewal must be up-to-date on their SYT
- We have been fielding a lot of questions about Unit Renewal. See below for some info that may help!
  - If an Adult member of a Unit has an expired SYT their membership becomes "suspended". A suspension doesn't expire registrations, but it does remove someone from the

roster(s). Once the Adult member completes their SYT, please notify the Registrar, Drew, and he can lift the suspension, which will automatically repopulate that individual on the roster. There is no system automated email upon completion, therefore it is essential to notify Drew of completion. His email is

Drew.Veitenheimer@scouting.org.

- A unit needs at least 5 registered adult leaders. Once the following positions are filled, other positions can be filled.
  - Unit leader
  - Committee Chair
  - At least 2 Committee Members
- Additionally, a unit needs a Chartered Organization Representative (COR). A COR can also fill the Committee Chair role or the Committee Member role. The COR is the <u>only</u> adult that can fill 2 paid positions in the same unit.
- A Pack must also have one Den Leader. This is not required for Troops.
- All Adults on unit renewal need current SYT.
- Renewal fee is \$100. This fee can be paid in the Scout office.
