

CREW/SHIP/POST 100-POINT ADULT PARTICIPATION FORM

Older Youth programming in Scouting America are led and shaped by participants themselves. Adults support Scouts by providing guidance, safety, and mentorship while allowing youth leaders to plan and carry out the program. **Each family is asked to commit to at least 100 points of volunteer service during the year.**

- Please consider selecting at least one role from Section A before choosing options from Sections B or C, as these positions are essential to delivering a strong program.
- You may combine multiple roles to reach 100 points.

Your involvement directly impacts the quality of the program your child receives. When each family contributes, no one person carries the full load—and our Scouts benefit from a stronger, more engaging experience.

POINTS & DESCRIPTIONS

YEAR-ROUND LEADERSHIP – Registered Scouting positions

100 - ADVISOR OR ASSISTANT – *Program Leadership.* Work directly with Scouts providing direction, coaching, and support. Complete online training, attend monthly committee meeting, and weekly meetings.

100 - TITLED COMMITTEE PERSON – *Behind-the-scenes support.* Perform a titled job, complete online training, attend monthly committee meeting, and visit weekly meetings.

100 - NEW MEMBER COORDINATOR – *Behind-the-scenes support.* Welcome, engage, and support youth and their families before, during, and after joining so that all members feel a strong sense of belonging.

100 - DISTRICT LIAISON – *Behind-the-scenes support.* Attend the monthly District Roundtable to represent and gather information for the unit. Attend other District and Council events as necessary.

MAJOR EVENT LEADERS – Seasonal or project-based roles

80 - SIGNATURE EVENTS – Lead one of the signature events. *Short-term, event-based role.*
